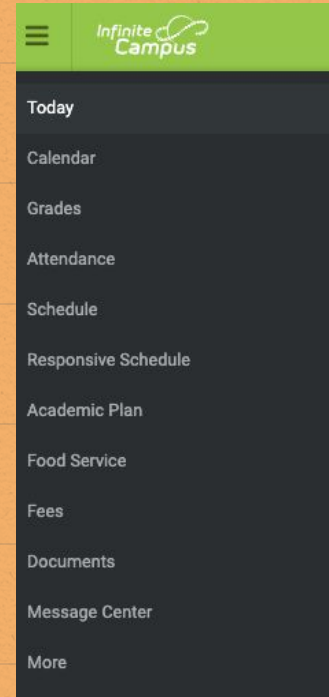
STEP 1

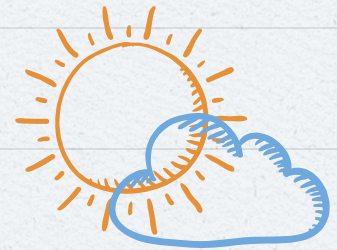
